Friday, Sept. 15, 2023:

HISTORIC HAYWARD FIELD



With over a 100 year history, this venue was already the nation's most storied track and field venue. In 2020 a 2-year renovation project was completed and Hayward Field has now become the premier venue in the world for Athletics, having just hosted the World Athletics Championships in the summer of 2022.

The facility has 12,500 permanent seats with a capacity to expand up to 25,000. The state of the art architectural design has created a “theater” for track and field with a 9-lane track, spacious seating, unobstructed sight lines, new big screen, and the multi-story landmark tower.

Athletes have access to indoor training areas encompassing all athletic disciplines. The school's Department of Human Physiology is housed in the facility, and fans can learn about the history of track and field in Hayward Hall.

Rainbow Warrior Football Practice @ Willamette University



Willamette University in Salem, OR, has been home for many student-athletes from Hawaii over the years, such as Tommy, Ron, and Cal Lee, to name a few.

A historic connection to Hawaii is their 1941 Football Team, nicknamed “the Pearl Harbor Team”. After a successful season that fall, the team was rewarded with a trip to Hawaii for a series of games with San Jose and the University of Hawaii. Willamette would lose to Hawaii 20-6 on Dec. 6. The next morning they were about to go on a tour of the island when Pearl Harbor was attacked.

After the attack, Head Coach Roy “Spec” Keene volunteered his players for 10 days of guard duty.

Four individuals from that team have been inducted into their school’s Athletics Hall of Fame.
