CONFERENCE REALIGNMENT LATEST

After the latest round of college conference realignment drama, the University of Hawaii and its athletic teams are staying put.

While Hawaii is primarily a member of the Big West Conference, it has been a football-only member of the Mountain West Conference since the 2012 season. The Pac-12 Conference, reduced to just Oregon State and Washington State, officially took four Mountain West members on Sept. 12. Then on Tuesday, the conference took Utah State, giving the Pac-12 and Mountain West seven teams each.

The remaining seven teams signed a memorandum of understanding on Thursday, solidifying their status in the Mountain West from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2032.
